trusted local producers. We enhance the products by remaining faithful to tradition while always staying in step with the times.

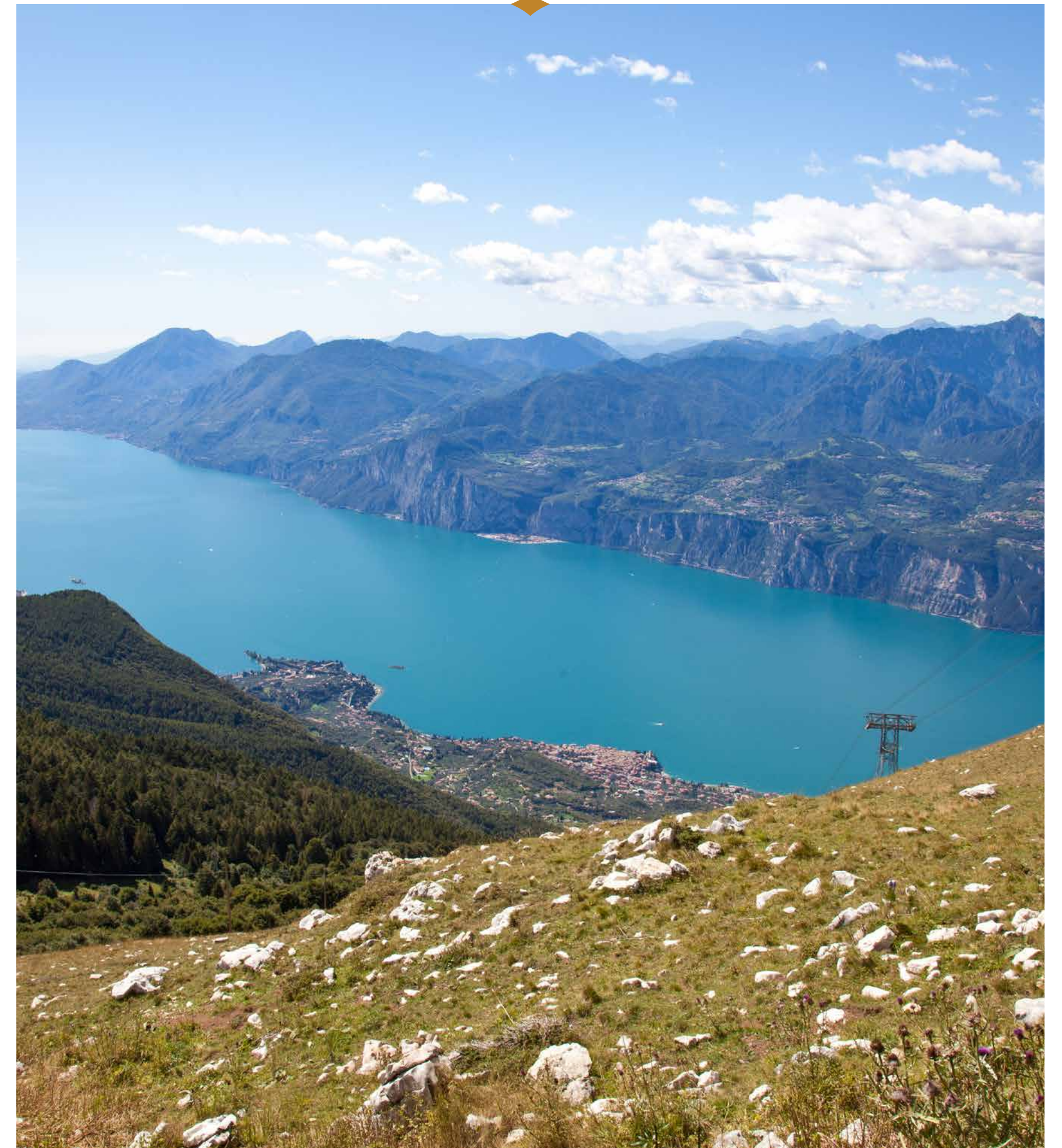
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# A territory full of treasures

# In the footsteps of James Bond

THE STRADA DELLA FORRA (GORGE)



As the name suggests, the famous Strada della Forra is carved into the rock and leads from Porto, on the Lombardy shore, to Pieve di Tremosine, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy. The road, quite sinuous and regulated by traffic lights in

some sections with a single lane, exceeds almost 400 m in altitude, offering spectacular views of Lake Garda. It also set the scene for a grand chase in the opening scene of the James Bond film "Quantum of Solace," starring Daniel Craig. The road

was inaugurated in May of 1913, after four years of construction, and was immediately considered an engineering masterpiece. It has recently undergone a major restoration and today promises pure driving pleasure.

# And only five remained

THE GHOST TOWN ON MONTE BALDO



Oscar, Elena, Giuseppe, Dolores, Roberta: they are the last five inhabitants of Campo, a small village above Brenzone dating back to the 11th century, where up to two hundred people once lived and water was drawn from a spring next to the church. A handful of abandoned houses, narrow alleys, walls now covered with ivy ... Campo looks like it came out of a sto-

ry book. For visitors, the village can only be reached on foot, along a mule track that starts from the lakefront and, passing through olive groves, with a 200 m elevation gain. In summer, Campo is the setting for some jazz concerts organized by the municipality of Brenzone, while in winter, over one hundred nativity scenes of various sizes are exhibited. But the oc-

casione in which the hamlet is most populated is on Easter Monday, when mass is celebrated in the medieval church of San Pietro in Vincoli, followed by refreshments. Then, when the lights of the events go out, absolute peace reigns here. Today, however, the inhabitants have electricity, telephone and internet - time has not stopped, not even in Campo.





## On top of Monte Baldo ...

... WITH THE NEW CABLE CAR



A holiday in Brenzone is not just about the lake, especially since summer 2022. Last August, a new cable car was finally inaugurated that takes mountain lovers up to Monte Baldo. The wait for commissioning seemed interminable: it took almost ten years to obtain the technical authorization for the opening, but now two brand new

lifts are climbing the slopes. The first is an iconic basket track with open cabins for two people at a time that starts from Prada, at 1014 m, and leads to Baito Turri, at 1550 m. From here, the journey continues aboard a two-seater chairlift, up to Costabella, with the Fiori del Baldo Hut at an altitude of 1850 m. During the entire jour-

ney, you can enjoy a truly privileged view of Lake Garda. At the summit, there are numerous possibilities for exploring the "Botanical Garden of Europe", as Monte Baldo is called due to its rich biodiversity of flora and fauna. A transport system for bicycles by cable car is planned for 2023.



## Gabriele D'Annunzio's home - museum

THE VITTORIALE DEGLI ITALIANI

In Gardone Riviera, on the western shore of Lake Garda, there is an impressive monumental complex, a precious testimony to the "inimitable life" of the eccentric poet Gabriele D'Annunzio (1863-1938), who made his home here, in the villa called "La Prioria". In addition to an amphitheatre - inspired by that of Pompeii - and an evocative garden park, during a visit to

the Vittoriale you can admire numerous objects belonging to the poet. A well-stocked library and a Steinway piano that belonged to Franz Liszt are just a few. The area of nine hectares also houses the "Museo D'Annunzio Eroee", dedicated to Italian companies during the First World War, and even a boat: the Nave Puglia, where today precious vintage models of mili-

tary ships are exhibited. On the highest hill is the Mausoleum, conceived on the model of Roman tombs, where the poet rests, even if it was finished a year after his death. From up here, you can enjoy a privileged view of the lake that extends from the Island of Garda to Monte Baldo—that alone is worth the visit.
